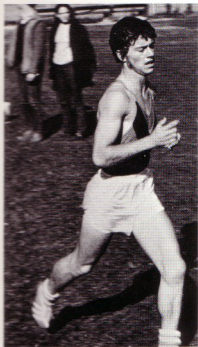

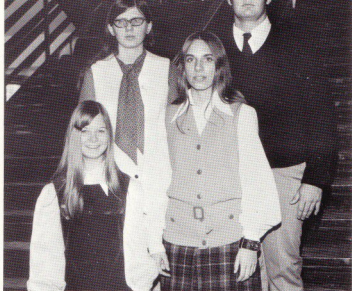

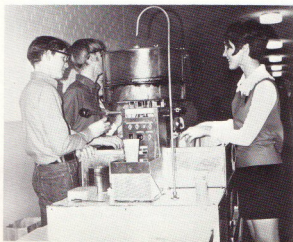
USHERETTES
